

DOG LICENSE APPLICATION FORM

- Per Wis. Stats. 174.05 (1), a dog license is necessary for the keeping of any dog over 5 months of age
- Licenses must be renewed each year, and are available at the Village office
- No dog license shall be issued until the applicant for such license submits proof that the dog has been vaccinated for rabies (Certificate of Rabies)
- Licenses expire December 31 each year, and must be renewed no later than April 1 of the following year
- After April 1, a penalty of \$5.00 will be added to the license fee
- You will promptly receive your certificate, license and tag by mail.
